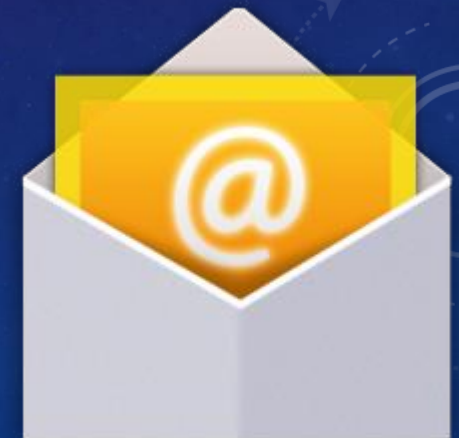

# A BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE CONCEPT

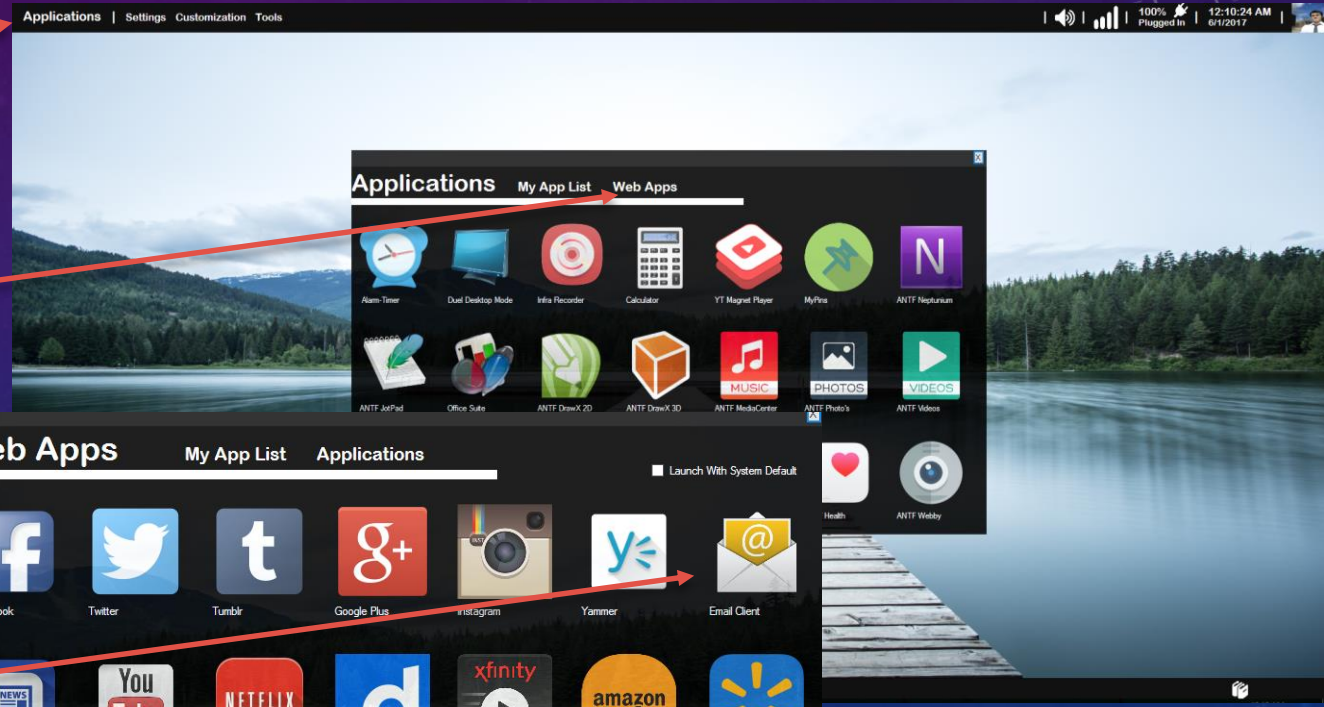
This is a OWA or (Online Web Driven Application) It uses “Platforms” to allow the user to jump between Email platforms like Gmail, Outlook, and so on. It does not save account information locally.

The only limitation of the client is that only knows platforms. It cannot differentiate that you have 2 or more Gmails, it just knows Gmail and you will need to sign out of your current gmail inbox to login to the other. This is basically the equivalent of you going online and doing this in your browser. This just happens to be one convenient app.

Step3: Click on Email Client

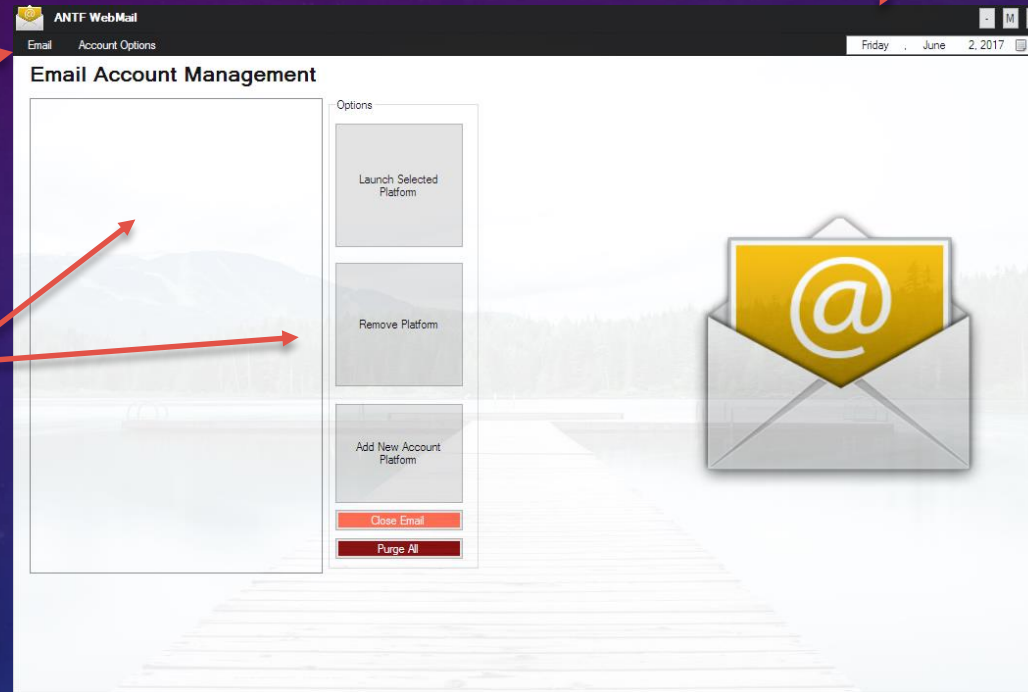

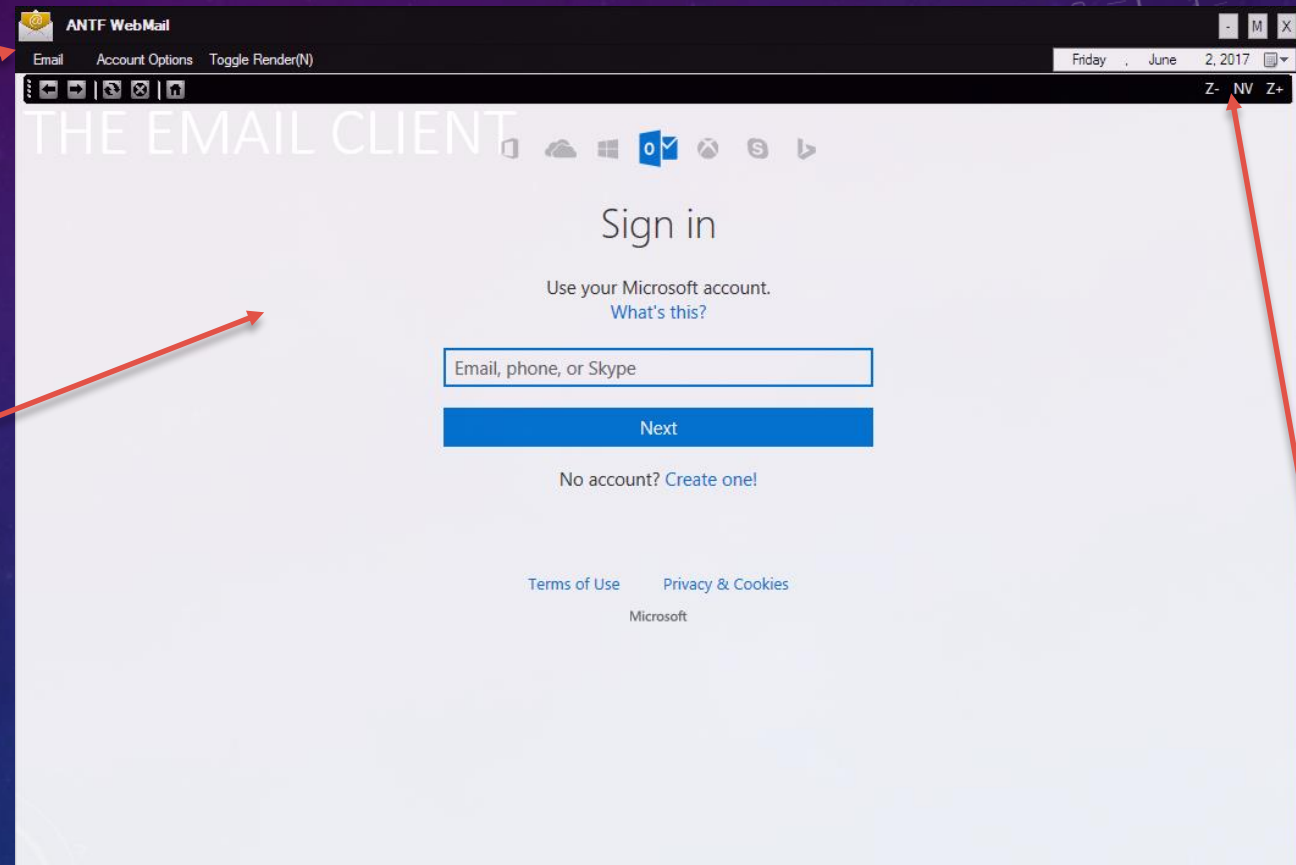
